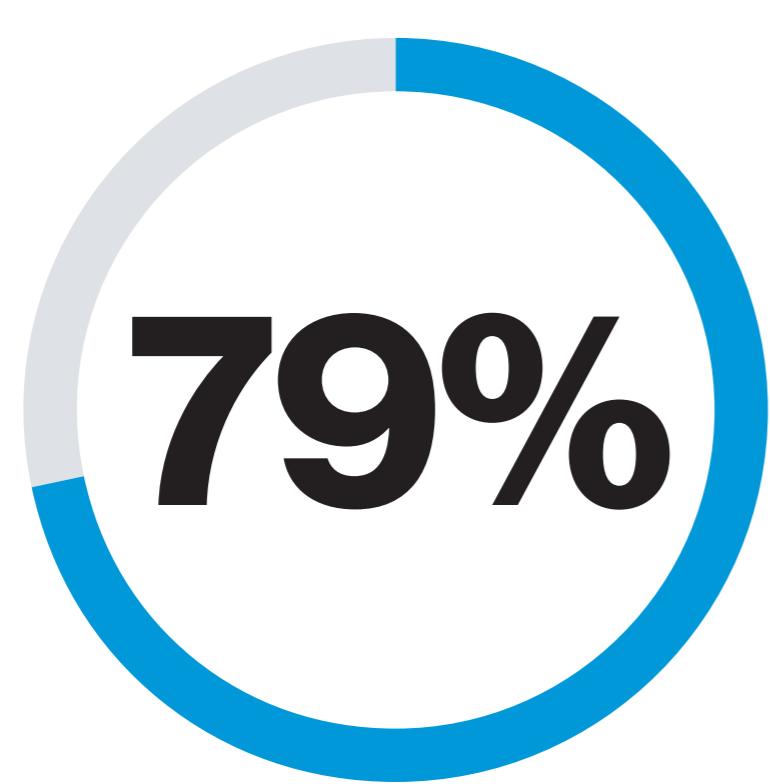

Use one number for mobile devices and desk phones to boost team efficiency.

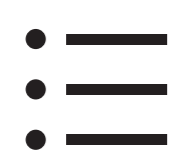

Business persona

Give employees their own business persona when they use their mobile devices, so if they need to call a customer, they can dial *67 and their mobile number will appear as the business number on caller ID.
